



IMPORTANT DRUG AND PHARMACY INFORMATION

Starting **January 1, 2022**, **Ochsner Health Plan** will work with MedImpact, our Prescription Benefits Manager, to manage your outpatient prescription drug benefits. With the rising cost of prescription drugs, our goal is to make it as easy and affordable as possible to get you the medication you need.

Getting a 30-day supply:

You may get a 30-day outpatient prescription drug at one of 65,000 participating retail pharmacies. To find a pharmacy near you and get driving directions, sign in to www.ochsnerhealthplan.com and use the online Pharmacy Locator tool.

With Ochsner Health Plan, you may get a 90-day supply of drugs on Tier One and Tier Two at no cost to you.

Getting a 90-day supply:

There are two ways to get a 90-day supply:

- 1) You may get a 90-day outpatient prescription drug by using one of our contracted mail order pharmacies, such as Ochsner Pharmacy and Wellness Destrehan.
- 2) Also, you can also get a 90-day outpatient prescription drug through many retail pharmacies with the same member cost-sharing as mail order. This way you don't have to worry about waiting for medicines to arrive, tracking down lost packages, medicine getting too hot (insulin), medicine getting too cold in the winter, etc. In addition, with COVID, many retail pharmacies now offer free drive-through, curbside, or home delivery services.

Prescription Drug Copays

Under your new pharmacy program, your copayments are based on a five-tier formulary structure. Every drug on the Ochsner Health Plan's Drug List is in one of five cost-sharing tiers. In general, the higher the cost-sharing tier number, the higher your cost for the drug:

- Tier 1 includes preferred generic drugs (this is the lowest tier)
- Tier 2 includes generic drugs
- Tier 3 includes preferred brand drugs
- Tier 4 includes brand drugs
- Tier 5 includes specialty drugs (this is the highest tier and limited to a maximum of 30 days' supply at a time)



Remember, with Ochsner Health Plan, you may get a 90-day supply of drugs on Tier One and Tier Two at no cost to you.

Ochsner Health Plan offers online tools to help you make informed choices regarding your formulary and copay options. You'll need your Ochsner Health Plan ID card to register. Starting January 1, 2022 go to www.OchsnerHealthPlan.com and click on the link to visit the MedImpact member portal. Once you register, you can sign into your account to:

- Check drug prices
- View benefit highlights
- View prescription history

How to Use Your New Pharmacy Program

Before January 1, 2022, you will get a new Ochsner Health Plan ID card(s). The new ID card will have pharmacy information to allow you to fill your prescriptions. To make sure you get your prescriptions, please show your new ID card to your pharmacy starting January 1, 2022, so they can update their system.
